Early Graduation Scholarship

The Early Graduation Scholarship is a scholarship available to Idaho public school students, who graduate at least one full year early. The scholarship is equal to 35% of the Average Daily Attendance (ADA) for a given school year. This equates to an estimated \$1,800. The award amount will double for student who graduate two years early and will triple for students who graduate three years early.
